Guest Speaker: Dr John Frederick

We are excited to have John joining us on **29th August** as guest speaker.

More about John:

Hello! I'm John Frederick, the lecturer in New Testament at Trinity College Queensland. In terms of a bio,

I still really resonate with the 'About the Author' section of a little book I made for a class project in primary school. It reads:

"John is a second grader at Veteran's Memorial Elementary School, he loves Nintendo, baseball cards, and spaghetti."

Since 1986 I have expanded my pasta palate to incorporate a wider variety of excellent and diverse macaronis. And, I've definitely moved on from collecting sports cards.
